

PRINCIPAL REPORT

Hebrews 11 is commonly known as the 'Hall of Faith'. It goes on to recognize many different Biblical figures for their faith. Our school theme this year was 'Mighty Men and Women of God'. We looked at the examples of some of the men and women of the Bible. 


















In the "Big-Inning
